
REMOTE CONNECTION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF CALGARY

Macintosh (OS X 10.6)

Establishing remote connection to the University of Calgary consists of two procedures: Create Secure VPN Connection and Connect to Server.


CREATE SECURE VPN CONNECTION.

- 1. Open **System Preferences** located in the **Applications** folder.
- 2. Open **Network** preferences
- 3. Select the + below the list of networks on left
- 4. From the **Interface** list select **VPN**
- 5. From the **VPN Type** list select **PPTP** and click **Create** button.
- 6. Type in your credentials:
 - a. In Server Address type: vpn.tri.ucalgary.ca
 - b. In **Account Name** type: tri\YOUR_ACCOUNT_NAME (Substitute YOUR_ACCOUNT_NAME with your user account)
 - c. Select Authentication Settings...
 - d. In **password** type your password and click **Ok**
 - e. Click Connect button.



CONNECT TO SERVER

- 1. In the Finder: from the Go menu select Connect to Server...
- 2. In Sever Address type: smb://tri1.tri.ucalgary.ca and click Connect button



- 3. Type in your credentials:
 - a. In Workgroup or Domain type: TRI
 - b. In Name type YOUR_ACCOUNT_NAME (Substitute YOUR_ACCOUNT_NAME with your user account)
 - c. In Password type your password.
- 4. Select your department and click **OK** button.
- 5. You should see a new icon on your desktop representing shared network drive.
