Course Overview:

This course is the second part of a year long introduction to the Sanskrit language. We will continue to learn Sanskrit grammar, declensions, vocabulary, sandhi, etc.

Required Text:

Madhav M. Deshpande, *Samskṛtāsubodhini: A Sanskrit Primer* (Ann Arbor, MI: Centers for South and Southeast Asian Studies, University of Michigan, 2003).

Suggested Materials:

Many, many packets of blank notecards (for flashcards)
Recording device (for recording and listening to paradigms, verb conjugations, vocabulary, etc.)

Evaluation:

Students will take a quiz daily covering the week's material. There will also be a final writing assignment – a translation – due during the final week. Participation and homework will also count heavily toward the final grade.
