2. Economic Growth (Chapter 6~7)
3. Saving, Investment, and Government Deficits (Chapter 8~9)
4. Money and Business Cycle (Chapter 10~11)
5. Unemployment (Chapter 16)

Grade Determination and Final Examination Details:

Student performance will be evaluated through a collection of problem sets (worth 30%), two midterms (worth 20% each), and final exam (worth 30%). Tests and final exams are marked on a numerical (percentage) basis, then converted to letter grades. The course grade is then calculated using the weights indicated above. As a guide to determining standing, these letter grade equivalences will generally apply:
