Course Description

HTST 213 introduces students to political, economic, and social developments in Canada from Confederation until the Constitutional debates of the 1980s and 1990s. We will examine how race, class, and gender shaped people's lives and how they understood important political and economic events. We will also explore changing conceptions of nation, citizenship, and identity.

Assignments

Students will submit two essays: a short document analysis and a longer research paper. The examination will be during the exam period.
