
History 361: The United States Since 1877 Winter, 2014

HTST 361 introduces students to United States history from the end of the Civil War to the present. Course themes include culture, economy, politics, and international relations.

Coursework will consist of a midterm and final exam, both in essay/short answer format, and a research paper based in part on documents to be assigned for the course. Our required textbooks are Paul S. Boyer, et. al., *The Enduring Vision: A History of the American People. Volume II: Since 1865* (Cengage Edition, 2011) and Upton Sinclair's *The Jungle*, with additional essays and book chapters provided through Blackboard.
