

## Math 249/251 Assignment/Quiz Syllabus Fall 2007

All section numbers refer to sections in the textbook: *Calculus - Early Transcendentals*, Jon Rogawski, *Second Printing*. Normally the quizzes will emphasize certain topics within the stated sections. Since some lab sections write quizzes on Mondays and Tuesdays, the material taught on the previous Friday is generally not heavily tested but a simpler type of question might be given. Due dates for the assignments will be (tentatively) on the following Sunday at 11:59 pm.

In any quiz week half of your class will take a quiz in MS 317 and the next week the remaining half will take the quiz. For example, if you are teaching L03 and B09,10,11,12 then in the first week B09 and B11 will write the quiz (quizA) and B10 and B12 will write the next week (quizB). The quizzes in adjacent weeks will be different and cover some different material as shown in the schedule below.
