

All you need to know about: Midterm Math 253/lec 06

When? *Wednesday March 07, 2007; 12:00pm-12:55pm*: Please show up at 11:50am, so that we can start the exam on time.

Where? *CHC 119*: CHC is Craigie Hall, Block C. It is the end of the building that links to Murray Fraser Hall and the Library and is also on the road where the bus loop runs around Parking Lot 1.

What? 10 multiple choice questions (25 minutes: each 1 mark) followed by 4 long answer questions (30 minutes: each 4 marks).

How? Be prepared “*at least*” by reviewing the weekly worksheets, the examples of your lecture notes and the webwork assignments. It will be also very helpful if you solve as many problems as possible from the exercises of the covered sections of your text book.

Important Notes:

- *The exam is absolutely “closed book/notes” and calculators are NOT allowed*: All the formulas that may be needed and are hard to memorize will be given on a separate sheet.
- The scantron answer sheets along with the multiple choice questions will be given to you at the beginning of the exam. Booklets including long answer questions will be put underneath your seats after 10 minutes. The scantrons will be collected after “*25 minutes*” and then you may start the long answer part. If you finish the multiple choice part in less than 25 minutes, you may start the long answer part immediately.
