Assignments (best 10 out of 11)	20%
Midterm test (2)	30% (Feb 14 and Mar 21 during the lecture)
Final Examination	50% (To be scheduled by the Registrar)

A passing grade on the final is required for a student to pass the course.

Each piece of work (assignments, midterms, final examination) submitted by the student will be assigned a percentage score. The student's average percentage score for the various components listed above will be combined with the indicated weights to produce an overall percentage for the course, which will be used to determine the course letter grade [bearing in mind that an F grade will result if the student does not pass the final exam]. The conversion between course percentage and letter grade is given below:
