Course Objectives:

The internship will include intensive exposure to various professional issues, the opportunity to work with a diverse range of clinical populations and problems, and advanced training in the use of specific psychological assessment and intervention strategies.

This course is only open to students in the Clinical Psychology program.

Evaluation:

This internship will be evaluated on a Pass/Fail (Credit/No Credit) basis, based upon the recommendation of the internship staff. In order to facilitate discussion, or to deal with performance that may lead to a recommended failure, an interim evaluation of the student is expected.
