<b>Text(s)/Readings:</b>	Music will be provided. A deposit maybe required that is refunded upon return of the music loaned by the U of C. Learning a transcribed solo, downloading and studying sound recordings and other assignments will be given.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Permission of the Department. You will be asked to provide personal funds for touring to the USA done this year.
<b>Course Description</b>	The rehearsal and performance of literature composed and arranged for large jazz ensemble, with an emphasis on individual improvisation.
<b>Course Objectives</b>	To learn jazz ensemble music of various composers in styles such as latin, swing, bebop, bossa, fusion, rock and ballad. Study aspects of musicianship such as balance, blend, intonation, phrasing and style. Improvisation skills and techniques will also be addressed.
<b>Course Activities</b>	Weekly rehearsals, listening assignments and extra rehearsals and concerts each term. Section leaders will arrange sectionals on a weekly basis, of which all students are required to attend.
<b>Course Content</b>	Study and performance of the music of Mintzer, Jones, Basie, Ellington, Coltrane and others in a big band setting. An emphasis on improvisation and creativity.
